

# CHS Landmark: 696 Centre Rd

## *Landmark Award*



Located on Centre Road, ¼ mile north of Clinton Hollow, the Perepeluk-Fitzpatrick home was constructed about 150+ years ago. Not a grand house in the sense that it is a large structure with many rooms and exquisite detailing, it is instead a remarkably fine example of a 19<sup>th</sup> century farm laborer's (Michael McCormick) home. To be sure this small structure has had several additions over the years, nevertheless its original structure remains essentially intact and additions have been added with the same eye for detail as were found in the original structure. Using photographs, maps and floor plans, Stephen presented a detailed and well-documented history of the home and some of its occupants at the Society's annual dinner.
