

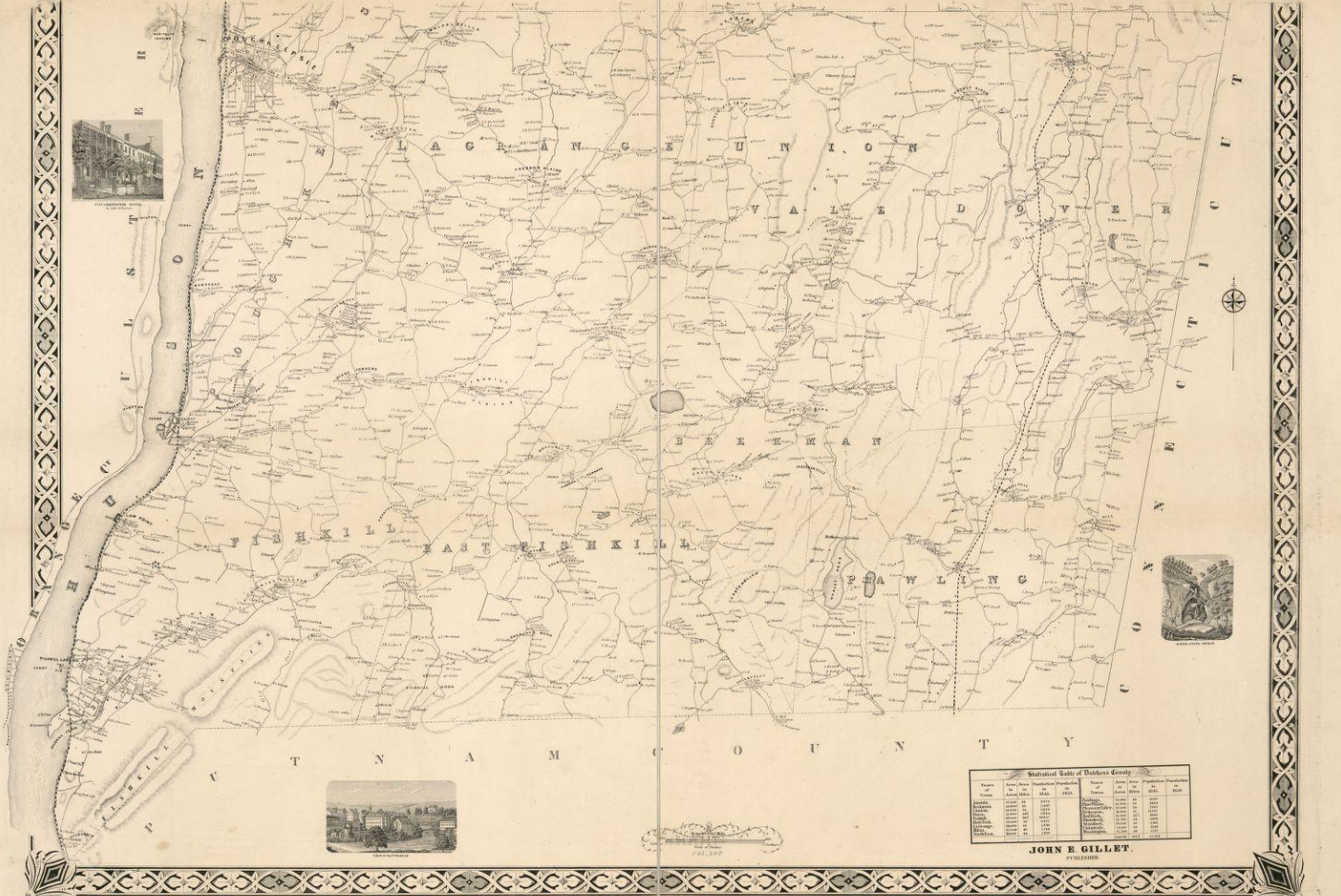
# MAP OF DUTCHESS COUNTY
