

**D.C. SPORTS MUSEUM EXHIBIT OPENS**

Our Society is proud to present the extensive memorabilia collection of the Dutchess County Sports Museum, Hall of Fame organization. Organized in 1977, the Hall of Fame recognizes outstanding local athletic talent and achievement thru formal induction each year to their group. All sports are represented in their membership and collection, including:

ice skating	handball	basketball	baseball
boxing	bowling	ice boating	swimming
golf	tennis	field hockey	roller skating

The Museum's artifacts have been carefully unpacked, selected for exhibit, and in many cases, painstakingly worked on to preserve them for future generations by our Society exhibit directors George Greenwood and Bill McDermott. In doing so, we have provided an important service to our Dutchess County area that goes beyond the current exhibit.

Some of the notable items on display are:

- \* a complete photo portrait gallery of all Hall of Fame members
- \* vintage photos of sports teams from the early 1900's on
- \* extensive news articles documenting significant achievements by Hall of Fame members
- \* 3-D collection of vintage sports items (uniforms, gloves, bats...)
- \* a giant commemorative baseball bat
- \* medals, trophies, and banners
