



## “Building Clinton: An Architectural Survey 1760 – 1965”

The many styles and history of over 350 vintage homes in the Town of Clinton were professionally surveyed and documented just prior to this resulting important publication. Relatively little change has occurred in the last 200 years and many structures are well preserved and appreciated by owners and town residents. Over 130 color photographs display the varied styles of homes – Greek Revival, Gothic, German Classical, Tudor, and more. Four periods of the town history are covered, as is the methodology and selection criteria of the survey. An especially detailed appendix includes year built and historical notes on over 450 significant properties, both private and public.
